- 2023/24 Budget Updates Beth Popcorn day is in the positive! Money still needs to be collected from a few people for the winter market and the middle school is going to pay us for the inventory. Kelly needs to turn in receipts but we are right around \$5,000 for income. Miori martial arts had 21 students, more than last time, some of those kids registered with Miroi for further lessons. That was a \$630 check. MH suite update room has been updated and they still have about \$1,000 leftover. New social worker has an amazon wishlist (books, decor, thera-putty). She would like items for her room. We would like to determine if that room will be used in future for UPK.
- Beth will send a wishlist so we can review and make a vote. Send out AFRs to be in for March and add correct wording and possible limitations.
- Account balance Beth \$23,557.77. May not include the \$9,101 that was deposited today.
- Membership Update Lindsey 134-unsure if we have 100% of teacher participation.
 We need to review and make sure we ask those who have not joined yet to become members. NIkki will get a list of teachers so we can cross reference.
- Board openings for 23-24 & people in mind for VP, treasurer or OAL.

 - o We need to start thinking of people who can fill positions- VP, treasurer, OAL.
 - o By April we need to have the nominees to vote in in May.
- Virtual meetings- Difficult to coordinate. Could be a function of the OAL to facilitate the virtual piece and operate a possible chat function. Need to get school wifi password to be able to utilize any platform. Amanda will offer a poll online to see who would be interested in a live stream option for the next meeting.
- Laker Exchange- Nikki- Agreed to save for spring book fair because there will be a parent night then.
