- \$30,000 from PTA going towards playground shade and buddy bench as soon as numbers are finalized

Committee/Activity Wrap Up:

- 2019 Carnival summary Nikki Great turnout despite large, late day storm
 - Only net \$186.00
 - Note to take attendance next year
 - Note to advertise that it is a community event in 2020 & mention more at kindergarten orientation
- School Supply Kits Kate May use a different company next year so we can use teacher specific lists and possibly ship to homes
- Curriculum Night Liz Sold some spirit wear and got new PTA members. Attendance seemed lower than last year.
- Fall Picture Day Nikki Great amount of volunteers this year
 - Note to adjust volunteer times next year to 2 hr intervals 8 am to 10 am, 10 am to 12 pm. Kids start coming in at 8:10, kids done by 11:45 then teachers go through. Diane Jillson is already offering to help next year
 - Spring pics are a way to cover yearbook. Lifetouch will provide yearbooks to all students because of our participation. Jen Bry-Gornia asked if hardcover was an option - it's not due to printing times. PTA does pay for pics not returned in Spring so we need all packets returned if not purchased.

2019 Upcoming Events:

- Box Tops Liz some manufacturers are moving to electronic box tops & require an app to scan your receipt within 14 days of purchase.
 - $\circ~$ BS receives 10 cents per box top and raised about \$900 last year
 - This year will be a combination of paper box tops and electronic ones
 - Mike Sinsabaugh will help coordinate marketing the transition with Liz Cobb.
 - Notice to be sent out soon with first submission around Nov 1
 - School-wise incentive instead of by class too much to keep track of/too hard to split receipt amongst several kids
- Popcorn Fridays Casey still needs volunteers but everyone says it's a very fun event to volunteer for. Noted that you can bring younger children along when volunteering. ** Kate Sinsabaugh spoke with Casey Frazee after the meeting, she will look into healthier toppings, cost, and ingredient lists.
 - 25c for a bag of popcorn, no one is refused. This shouldn't be a money maker, but somehow we make a couple hundred dollars each year (\$500 in 2018/19).
- Save Around Christie, Diane All ready to send home October 3rd
 - Save Around runs from 10/7-10/21, \$25/book, book sent home must be returned or purchased otherwise PTA pays for missing book
 - Same incentive as last year with shirts/hoodies but no free books this year
 - Raised about \$6,500 last year, normally around \$5k but with shirt incentive we did better

- Spirit Wear Chris and Erica Caz Gear used last year with a couple issues, but possibly issues have been resolved. Spiniker is alternate company with more options, but a little more expensive.
 - Erica and Chris to coordinate, include pride gear like mugs, bumper stickers, etc
 - To be distributed before Christmas
- Penguin Patch Liz 12/16-12/20 will need some adult volunteers, fun event to watch kids decide gifts for people they need to shop for.

2020 Upcoming Events - Overview

- Enrichment Courses coming in spring
 - \$25/child for 6 weeks (one class per week), 10 student minimum per class to make it feasible, sign up through Caz Rec Desk (<u>https://cazenovia.recdesk.com/Community/Home</u>)
 - Discussed possible dates to start. Agreed to start week after February break and end before Spring break.
 - Emily Stevens to start asking teachers soon about classes offered and confirm dates are OK. Will have list ready by winter break. Emily will compile class offering by mid-Jan. Erica to make flier to send out on Peachjar mid-Jan (<u>https://app.peachjar.com/flyers/all/schools/148811</u>)
 - Tuesday-Thursday classes will be offered
