Business Items:

- 2020/21 Budget Update Becky budget is looking great going into 2020-21 with \$17-18K in surplus.

- AFR Status Becky due 9/30. Some submitted, likely all will receive the funding they have requested. Still planning for field trips so that the money is budgeted even if the event can't happen.

Teachers were appreciative of the gift bag (a different approach than past years) filled with coupons & goods from local businesses.
