#### **Business Items:**

- 2020/21 Budget Update Becky looking very good. Fundraisers doing well
- Account balance Becky \$17,985.53
- AFR Status Becky 95% complete. Orders being sent into school, all but 2 teachers have been repaid at this time
- Membership Update Michelle 78 members with 11 of those being teachers (last year was 4 teachers)

## Committee/Activity Wrap Up:

- Opt-out Fundraiser <a href="https://bit.ly/2FO7XqO">https://bit.ly/2FO7XqO</a> well received especially after printed form went home with students. Raised \$3-4K so far. Took place of Save Around Books. WAY easier to execute. Will keep for next year (update from Becky Opt Out at \$2665
- Picture Day (retakes 11/12) Lifetouch has the 12/17 date available just waiting on ok from the school. Remote students retakes will be 12/11. If retakes can't happen we always have the spring pictures.
- Snack Days going really well in school and remote students really appreciate it. 3 done for remote (ice cream, gold fish, pretzels), 2 for in-school (gold fish, pretzels)
- Box Tops submission has brought in about \$50 which is substantially lower than past years but with the new way of "collecting" box tops it's a little harder for some to do/remember to do it.

Has been collecting a ton of homemade products, amazon purchases from our wishlists, etc.
  - Products are \$10 and lower
  - Kelly went to school and created 3 different display cases to show the students what to expect this year! Displays will be up for 3 weeks
  - Products are currently being stored at the nursery at the Cazenovia Presbetarian church so a big thank you to them!!
  - School would like consistent as far a volunteers go so there is less chance for exposure/easier contact tracing
  - Remote students will be able to shop on 12/11which is also a remote packet pick up day

- Will have an envelope system with the day/time students will be able to shop. This will
  make it easier to pick out gifts, know how much to spend on everyone, etc.
- Raffle Baskets We also have enough items to do 16 gift baskets for a winter raffle!
  - o Idea for money to go towards something special for the teachers!
  - o Will all be online and will run around December Kelly looking into different options for this.
- Square 1 Art Jaci Korver/Amy Austin Getting started early just in case students have to go remote. Remote students should already have for a project now
  - We are ahead of schedule currently and hoping to get the art in before Christmas to be able to have the spring shopping available and delivered before Mothers Day
- 4th Grade Moving Up Gretchen/Nikki Skeele Gretchen and Nikki are going to get together at some
  point this month to hash things out and come up with different options as far as distanced moving up
  day or even maybe being able to get everyone together depending on what is going on with COVID.
  - We will then put together next month, a zoom meeting for all those who have volunteered to help out so far to discuss and get more ideas.
- Summer Learning Resources using earned Scholastic Rewards Jen Bryz-Gornia & Katie McGinnis -Going to get together a summer workbook from Scholastic that is age appropriate for all Burton Street students.

\$5.50 each - about \$3,000 all together for a whole school

  - Katie is also going to make a general teacher wish list and we can post on the website for parents to look at and purchase if they want. That way the teachers don't have to feel like they are overstepping, asking for classroom books so close to the holidays.   - Looking for fun stuff for them rather than disinfecting wipes etc.
