PTA Presidents Welcome - Nikki Skeele & Nicole Maggio -

Principal Update – Kara May –

- There are NO WORDS to express my sincere gratitude for the Burton Street PTA. To say "you do so much for the school" would be an understatement. I have been unbelievably impressed with your energy, support, visibility, initiative and advocacy. A true and sincere thank you to every one of you who support our teachers and students.
- Adaptive Playground Equipment: We are waiting on the factory to send the missing parts for 2 of the 4 structures they were supposed to be here this week. Installation goal was for this upcoming week, pending part delivery to the contractor. We were told that the manufacturer should prioritize that order since it was missing from the original order but still waiting!
 - Once this is done we will have a much better and more realistic understanding of the square footage for Hazel's Path, as there are NYSED regulations regarding playground safety padding/ground cover for different types of equipment.
 - Colleen Shaw has been working with me along the way and is eager to participate in the project, but, until specifics regarding square footage and material regulation is noted - we are in a holding pattern re: path.
- June 15 BBQ: bringing it back this year! Based on feedback this has historically been pretty chaotic so I have worked with Char Grimes in Food Service to make it more smooth for everyone involved. We are still ironing out some last minute details-parents/guardians will receive more detailed information as we get closer. Cost will be \$3 per adult lunch; pay ahead of time via myschoolbucks account; if you need to pay at the door you will not receive change (change will go onto your students myschoolbucks account); parents will NOT go into the school and sign in everything will take place on the front green or side yard (closest to Clark St.); no rain date. Kara will send menu. Younger siblings no cost.

- Winter Market policies created policies and procedures with input from winter market chairs to allow for purchasing year round. There is a spreadsheet up and running of inventory and costs. Carol wants to keep this running like a business - with checks & balances of what's in stock, budget left & keep Kelly submitting receipts in time. How do we keep the Burton St sale items as Burton St and not have it merge to the Middle School sale? Let's have more discussion about how to keep the inventory/costs/sales of Burton St with Burton St and not somehow sold at the MS and MS receives our profits.

Committee/Activity Wrap Up: 10 min

- Teacher Appreciation -
- Yearbook final cost We ordered 526 to cover 448 students and 78 staff, which came to a total of \$3824.02 and are scheduled to be delivered to the school on or around 6/7. We originally thought yearbooks would be around \$5k, but we were able to reduce the page count down to 24, which reduced the price to \$7.27 per book. Talk of having teachers request if they want a book next year.
- Book fair \$10,545, receive our profits in SD \$5,272. How do we spend that? Flex seats & book bins, fund kids in need for the next sale, purchase books from teacher wish lists. Reordering doesn't go well on Scholastic's end it's a very manual process. There really is no other option except Scholastic Barnes & Noble only does in store, Folletts stopped book fairs.
- Raise Craze update and vote on fund distribution focus on AOKs and not money. Monetary donations did not have to be made in order to participate.
 - o Total raised: \$22,795, 1,655 Acts of Kindness logged
 - After fees kept 94% with Raise Craze (\$21,355)
 - May 27th- Closing Ceremony during assembly, Bowling Party, DJed Ice Cream Party
 - vote on how to distribute funds: exact STEAM, exact yearbook, remainder to Hazel's pathway
