Principal Update – Kara May –

- Account balance Beth Alton \$39,182.31, coming out of that will be the \$14,600.60 for the inclusion pathway.

- Vote on stools for P/T Dept initially saw \$213 for four 12" stools, would like to buy 2 sets. \$183 set through Wayfair. Everyone is in favor of this stool purchase.
- Teacher Yoga after school Nicole Maggio Mrs Fey would like to bring an after school yoga program
 to the staff at Burton St. The PTA is needed to sponsor the event so that insurance is covered. All are
 in favor of sponsoring this event in order to have insurance coverage.
- Intro to committees we have quite a few committees in need of leads including Yearbook (some communication/work in late fall/early winter, ramps up in Feb), We Love Our Teachers (Valentines lunch), Talent Show, Teacher Appreciation (happens in May), Family/Movie Nights, 4th grade Moving Up Committee, Carnival (needs 2 more). Nicole has a sign up board for events that need help. Sign up after the meeting. Discussion about the opportunity to increase budgets if it's needed. We'd like to have the 4th grade moving up committee hold their own fundraising to help fund possible over-budgets for their event.
- Mike has offered to help coordinate a manual of our typical events the PTA runs so new possible chairs of events can check it out and know what's expected.
